

Epilobium canum 'Catalina'

Catalina California Fuchsia

Dudleya brittonii is a succulent with a large open rosette of waxy, chalk-like leaves. This variety of California Fuchsia is a relatively tall, upright perennial with orange red flowers. It is extremely showy when in full bloom in late summer and early fall. Catalina Fuchsia will grow in full sun to part shade but it prefers good drainage with a little extra water. The flower color is orange/red.
