-Western Redbud

Cercis Occidentalis Western Redbud

This deciduous shrub or small tree reaches 15' tall and 10' wide. Beautiful magenta flowers appear in spring, before the leaves appear. Foliage is apple green, turning yellow to red in the fall. Seed pods dangle on this tree in winter.

Rhamnus californica Coffeeberry

Coffeeberry is an evergreen shrub that grows native in the US West Coast . Coffeeberry is native from the Oregon Coast ranges through most of California into Arizona and Baja. This large shrub reaches 8' tall and 10' wide.







Aster chilensis Coast Aster

Coast Aster is a low growing California native aster with bright green leaves. It spreads quickly in regular watered gardens. Many lavender daisy flowers appear in summer and fall. This plants attracts butterflies.

The 'Emerald Carpet' is an evergreen groundcover that grows to 1' tall by 6'-8' wide. It is favored by many landscapers as the manzanita of choice for inland situations. It has dark green leaves and exhibits compact growth.





California Poppy




Eschscholzia californica California Poppy

This small annual (sometimes acts as a perennial) plant will grow to less than 1' tall and has light, small blue green leaves with gold and orange flowers that bloom in spring and summer.

Penstemon spectabilis Royal Beard Tongue

This shrubby perennial produces spectacular, blue purple to pink to white to red colored, tubular flowers on spikes, which is quite attractive to hummingbirds. Royal Beard Tongue can reach a mature size of about 3'-4' tall.









Salvia clevelandii Cleveland Blue Sage

The Cleveland Sage is a perennial shrub that grows 4' tall and wide. It has fragrant gray foliage and blue, lavender or white flowers that bloom between May and August. This shrub needs full sun and prefers well drained soil.



Heuchera sanguinea 'White Cloud' White Cloud Coral Bells

Tufts of rounded, light green leaves with a silver overlay make this Heuchera very attractive. Foliage has scalloped edges that densely covers the plant. This Heuchera produces wiry stems to 18" tall with clusters of tiny, white flowers.

Carex pansa California Meadow Sedge

This native Carex can be successfully used as a lawn substitute but requires significant water to obtain good coverage. Once coverage is reached, water can be reduced and maintenance is close to zero.
