Please Conserve We're in a Drought



The hospitality industry can make a huge difference when it comes to water conservation by offering guests water-saving options to reuse their linens and towels if they are staying more than one night. This can save thousands of gallons of water each month.

Please read these instructions to learn how to share the conservation message with our guests.

Bathroom Preparation



When preparing the room, please place door hangers (like the one pictured) on the bathroom door knob or on the towel rod.

Guests are encouraged to place any towel they would like to use again on the towel or shower curtain rod. If they want

their towels replaced, they will leave them on the bathroom floor or in the bathtub.

When you see a towel hanging on the towel or shower curtain rod, please refold it neatly, but don't replace it with a fresh one. Any towels left on the floor or in the bathtub should be replaced with a fresh towel.

Guest Room Preparation



Please place tent cards (like these pictured) on the room dresser or nightstand.

Place smaller flat cards on the bed pillow.



Guests will have options to reuse or have their bed linens changed. If the card is ON the pillow in the morning, this means they want housekeeping to change their bed linens. If the card is NOT ON the pillow in the morning, you only need to make up the bed, but not to change the linens.
